GUIDE LINES FOR SCHOLARSHIP EVALUATION

The scholarship committee of the YEE FUNG TOY FAMILY ASSOCIATION, SACRAMENTO, hereby approved and adopted the following procedures for the scholarship award program. In accordance with the MOO KAI COMMUNITY EDUCATIONAL AND WELFARE FUND SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM, the goals are to award the outstanding students of the YEES in schools and to help them to learn the Chinese cultures.

Requirements:

1. Schools attended by applicants must be accredited.
2. At least one of the parents of the student must be a registered member of the Yee Fung Toy Family Association, Sacramento. Minimum two (2) years of annual dues and convention fee (when required) must be paid prior to the submission of scholarship application.

Note: Students over eighteen (18) years old must register and pay their annual dues before they can be qualify for this scholarship.
3. One (1) full year school grade report card; i.e., 6th grade, 8th grade, 12th grade, or first two (2) years of college/university credit hour units must be submitted by the deadline for ranking evaluation.
4. Grade Point Average (GPA) must be 3.0 or above for eligibility to apply for the following scholarships:
 - a. The elementary school (6th grade) scholarship.
 - b. The middle school (8th grade) scholarship.
 - c. The high school (12th grade) scholarship.
 - d. The college/university (completion of first two (2) years of college; i.e., the freshman year and the sophomore year) scholarship (see requirement #6).
 - e. The special Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) scholarship (see requirement #7).
5. Method used for Grade Point Average (GPA) calculation:
 - a. Only the basic method (i.e., A+, A, A- = 4; B+, B, B- = 3; C+, C, C- = 2; D+, D, D- = 1) is accepted officially to calculate the Grade Point Average (GPA).

- b. Accelerated Honor Program/Advance Program (HP/AP) - i.e., one grade point is added to each basic grade - will not be accepted for the ranking computation.
 - c. Alternative method (i.e., A+, A = 4; A- = 3.7; B+ = 3.3; B = 3; B- = 2.7; C+ = 2.3; C = 2; C- = 1.7; D+ = 1.3; D = 1; D- = 0.7) will not be accepted for the ranking computation.
6. Requirements for college/university scholarship:
- a. One copy of current year grade report transcript (i.e., including all credit hour units of the freshman year and the sophomore year) must be submitted by the deadline for ranking evaluation.
 - b. Applicant must have completed fifty (50) or more semester hour units or seventy-five (75) or more quarterly hour units during the first two (2) years of college.
7. Requirements for special (SAT or SAT-II) scholarship:
- a. One copy of current year SAT or SAT-II score report must be submitted in on time for ranking evaluation.
 - b. Applicant must have a combined score (verbal and math) of **1250 or above**.
8. Each year, three (3) awards (first place, second place, and third place) will be granted for each scholarship. All winners will be posted at the Association and announced on the members meeting letter.
9. Multiple awards will be granted if two (2) or more students have the same Grade Point Average (GPA).
10. Scholarship Award Distributions:
- a. Elementary School (6th Grade):
 - First Place..... \$200.00
 - Second Place..... \$150.00
 - Third Place..... \$100.00
 - b. Middle School (8th Grade):
 - First Place..... \$300.00
 - Second Place..... \$200.00
 - Third Place..... \$100.00
 - c. High School (12th Grade):
 - First Place..... \$600.00
 - Second Place..... \$500.00
 - Third Place..... \$400.00

- d. College/University (completion of first two (2) years):
 - First Place..... \$700.00
 - Second Place..... \$600.00
 - Third Place..... \$500.00
- e. Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT):
 - First Place..... \$400.00
 - Second Place..... \$300.00
 - Third Place..... \$200.00
- f. Complimentary awards of \$50.00 will be given to:
 - All other qualified applicants meeting the minimum GPA score of 3.0
 - All other qualified applicants meeting the minimum SAT score of 1250 or above.

11. Requirements for Chinese School Tuition Assistance/Reimbursement:

- a. Student must be seventeen (17) years or younger.
- b. Only students who attend the Sacramento Chinese School (The Confucius Church School) are eligible for the tuition assistance/reimbursement.
- c. At least one of the parents of the student must be a registered member of the Yee Fung Toy Family Association, Sacramento. Minimum two (2) years of annual dues and convention fee (when required) must be paid prior to the request for tuition assistance/reimbursement.
- d. School tuition receipts must be submitted to the Association as proof for the reimbursement. Also one copy of the current school grade report card must be submitted to verify that he/she is in good scholastic standing and good citizenship.
- e. A student can submit only one request for tuition assistance/reimbursement each year to the Association at the end of the school year (i.e., usually the school year runs from September through May or June of the next year).
- f. The tuition assistance/reimbursement shall not exceed the tuition cost charged by the Sacramento Chinese School.
